The Inclusive Classroom Profile (ICP) is a Program Observation Instrument that assesses the implementation of inclusive classroom practices in classrooms where there is at least one child, ages 2-5, with an IFSP or IEP. The scale assesses 12 key practices with the strongest research base for supporting the education and development of young children in inclusive programs.
