Description The Vine Assessments™ are a series of developmentally-appropriate early childhood assessments from birth through PreKindergarten. The Vine Assessments are categorized as “Observational, Formative Assessments,” as follows: Observational = teachers complete the Vine Assessments on their students based on what they have observed in their interactions with the children. The students do not complete any portion of the Vine Assessments themselves. Formative = teachers can use results from the Vine Assessments as they prepare Lesson Plans. Teachers can plan activities specifically intended to work on areas that the children have not yet scored as ‘Achieved.’ The Vine Assessments are fully embedded within the LifeCubby™ software used for classroom documentation and communications with parents. Teachers use the LifeCubby app to post Observations for the parents and can use selected Observations as evidence for assessment indicators. Assessment indicators can be scored at any time. Vine Assessments are used for parent-teacher conferences at any time of the year. Teachers use LifeCubby for Lesson Planning and can review assessment status at any time for lesson planning purposes.
